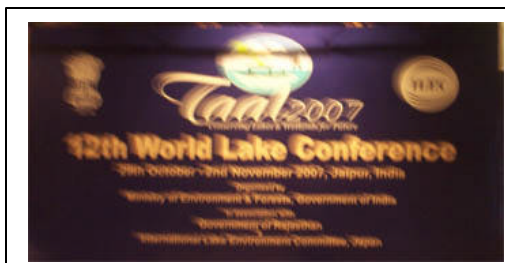

Governor of Ibaraki Prefecture, Japan were also present at the occasion -



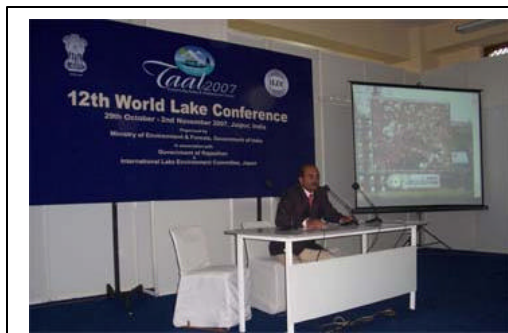

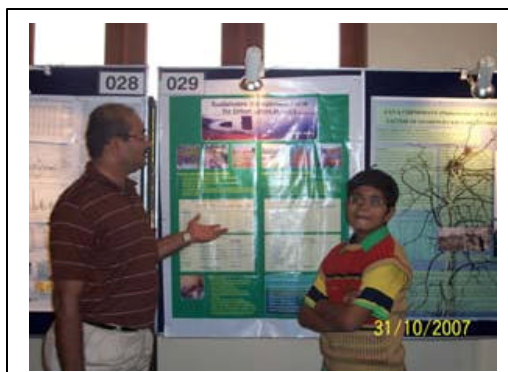
